That is how Ms. Dixon introduced herself on a phone call to Jeraldine Sanders. Ms. Dixon was interested in learning more about JCOK after a presentation Mrs. Sanders had given at a Retired Teachers Association meeting in Texarkana, Arkansas.

In her first year at JCOK, Ms. Dixon began volunteering part-time, the second year she volunteered more often, and by the third year, she was a full-time tutor. She used her creativity and her resources to challenge and motivate the children to dig deeper. She instructed the children on the E.N.R.I.C.H. (Educate-Nurture-Reach-Instruct-Coach-Help) creed, and they picked up on her creativity.

Ms. Dixon extended her gifts beyond the walls of JCOK into the Iron Mountain community. She created a Christmas basket filled up gifts, homemade crafts, cookies, candies, teas, and a stuffed animal for a member of the community for four years. Upon the sad news of Ms. Dixon's passing, there were parents and children who openly wept. We will continue Ms. Dixon's legacy of love and helping others with the annual Margaret Dixon Christmas Basket to be given to a member of the community.
